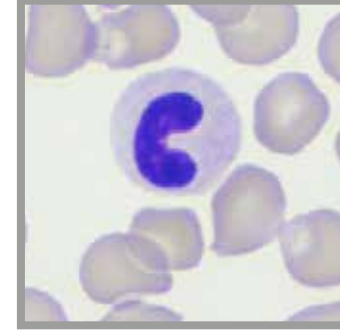

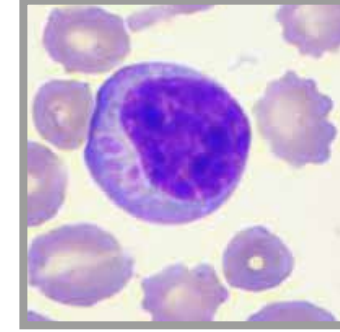

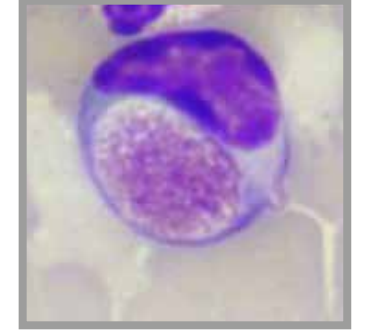
Sites for venipuncture, guinea pig:

Right: cephalic vein



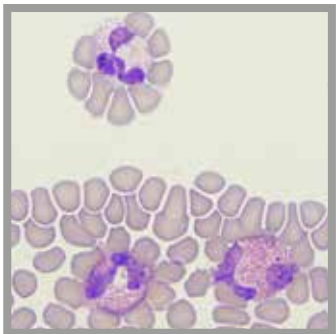

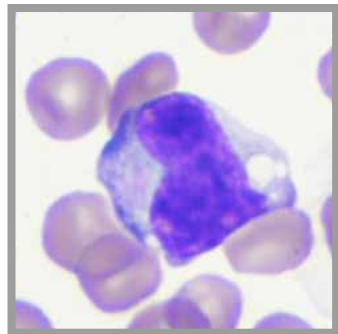

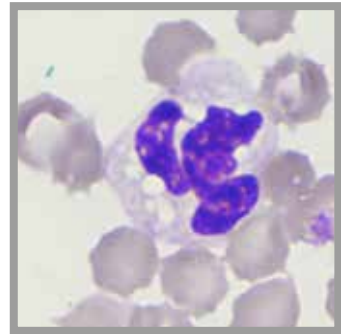

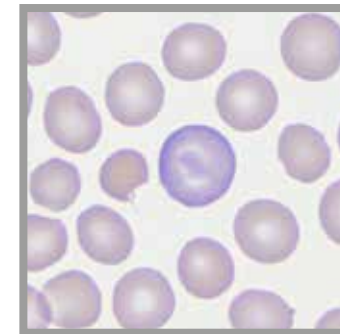

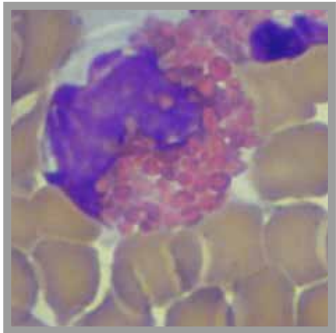

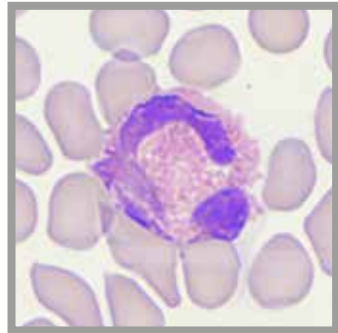

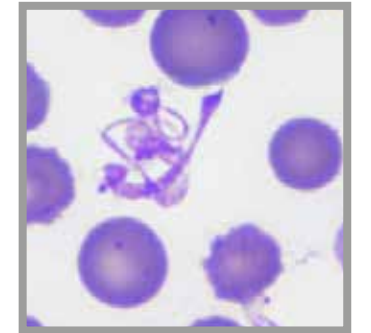

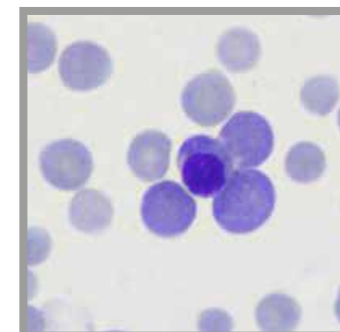

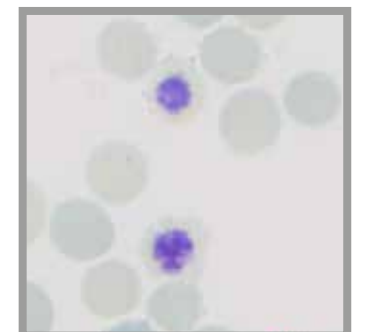

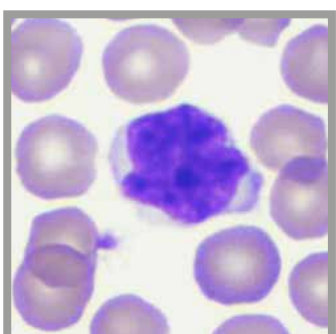

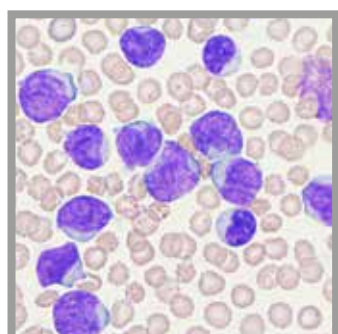

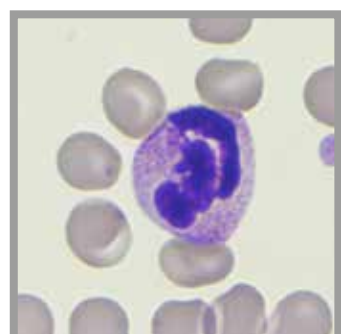

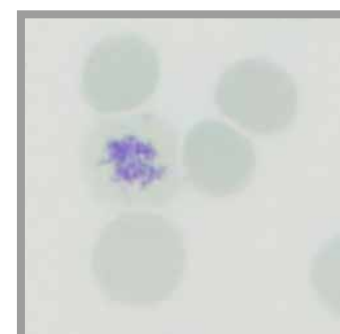

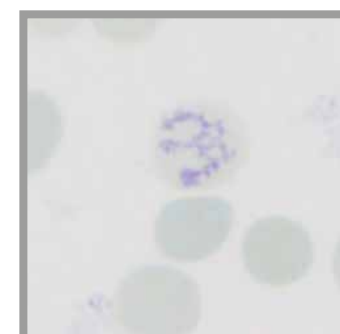
