Especially for oozing skin conditions




Skin scrapingEspecially for the detection of parasites


Air-dry



Stain Rapid stain, e.g. Diff-Quick




PyodermaDegenerate neutrophils and bacterial cocci


Eosinophilic granuloma, cat Eosinophils and squamous epithelial cells




